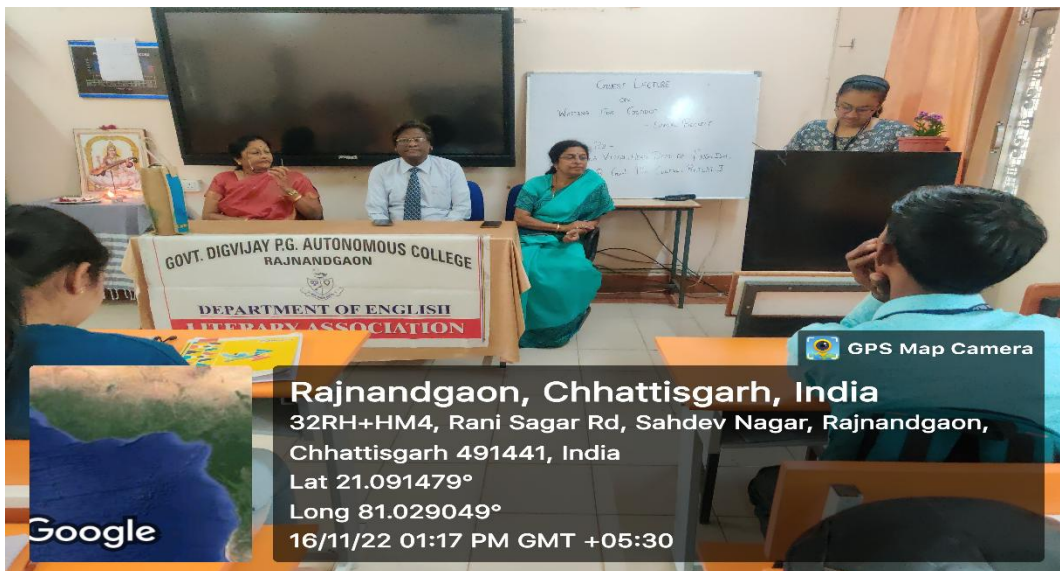
On 08/10/2022, to celebrate R.K.Narayan's birthday, students of PG classes organized a poetry and a story telling completion on the works of R.K. Narayan.
